1.0 Background:

PKSF has started implementing a 04 years project titled 'Skills for Industry Competitiveness and Innovation Program (SICIP)' jointly financed by the Government of Bangladesh (GoB) and the Asian Development Bank (ADB). The objectives of the project are to (i) deliver industry-relevant basic and mid-level skills training for priority and emerging industries and (ii) promote inclusive skilling and upskilling opportunities for women and socially disadvantaged groups through targeted training programs. 2.0 Project Period:

The employee will be recruited initially for 01 (one) year with an opportunity for performance-based annual renewal during the project period.

4.0 Duty Station:

The employee will be stationed at Dhaka. S/he will have to travel anywhere in Bangladesh including the most remote areas as per instruction of the PKSF.

5.0 Major Responsibilities:

Coordinators (Training, Assessment & Monitoring) will be responsible for ensuring the achievement of enrolment, training assessment and completion targets, and proper monitoring of training programs to ensure SICIP's quality standards. The followings are the major duties and responsibilities of the designated post:

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- Ensure the achievement of trainee enrolment, assessment, and training completion targets, with particular attention to the targets set for women and disadvantaged groups;
- Responsible for primary selection of training institutes according to the quality training criteria set by SICIP;
- Prepare effective training implementation plan for the partner institutes and oversee trainee selection process;
- Prepare a monitoring plan to conduct various types of monitoring activities to cover all partner institutes;
- Responsible for updating, developing, and finalizing course curricula/standards and relevant learning materials, assessment tools and ensuring quality of training, assessment & certification;
- Ensure the availability of competency standard, learning material and other training documents and activities at training centers;
- Follow SICIP's guideline to monitor the implementation of training programs, assessment and other related activities;
- Implement the account and financial management system of the PIU as per SICIP's guidelines;
- Ensure that all payments and expenditures comply with the SICIP's financial guidelines;
- Check out bills with required documents and ensure payment of TIs in due time;
- Ensure the achievement of job placement targets, with particular attention to women and disadvantaged groups;
- Conduct regular visits to partner training institutes to monitor the implementation of training programs;
- Prepare and submit periodic reports for SDCMU highlighting all activities;
- Carry out any other tasks assigned by the Chief Coordinator/management of PKSF.

6.0 Academic Qualifications and Experience:

- Masters in Social Science/Business Administration/Business Studies with at least 05 year's working experience in relevant field.
- Candidates must possess a minimum of two first class or equivalent grade in their academic career.
